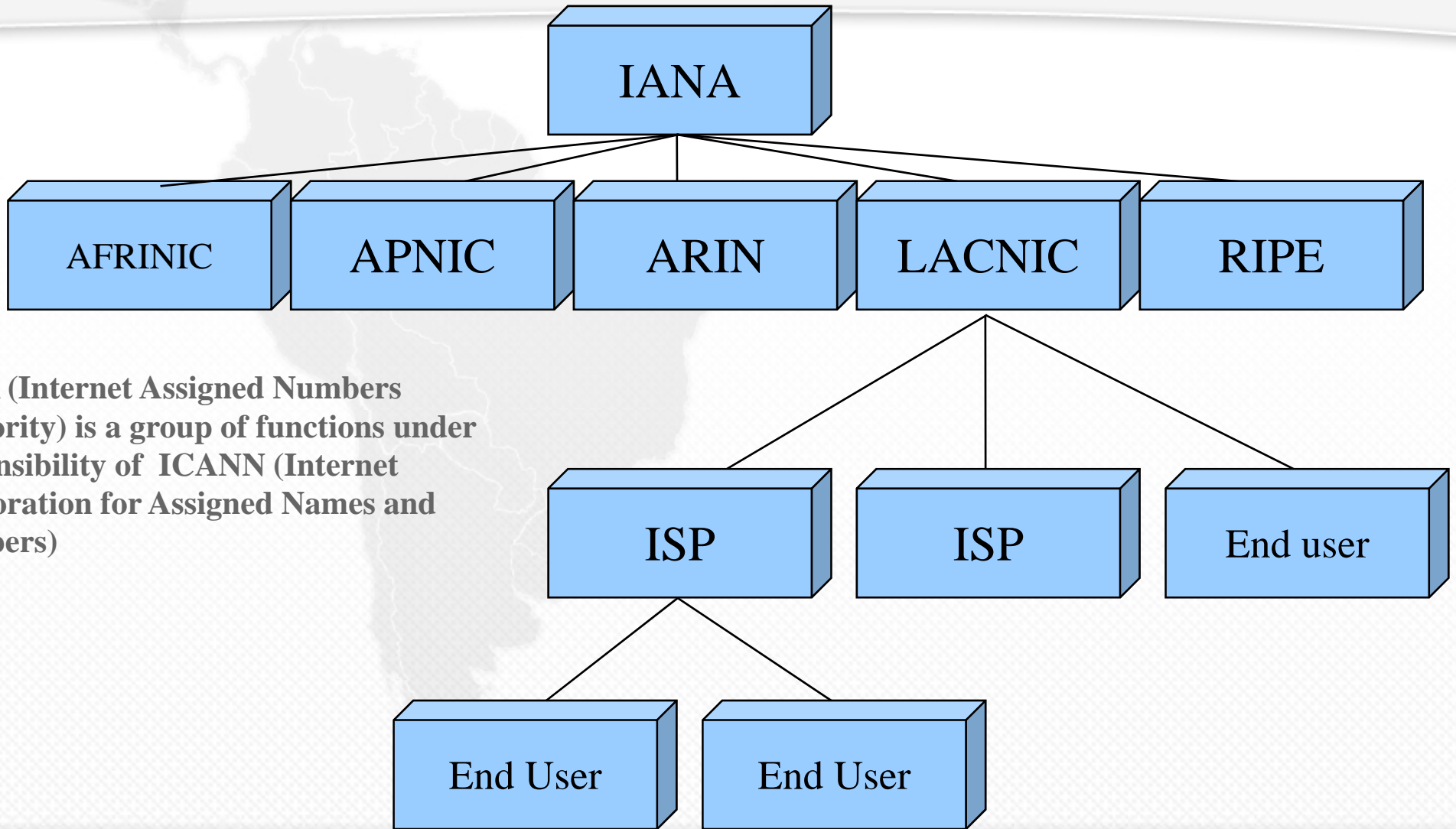

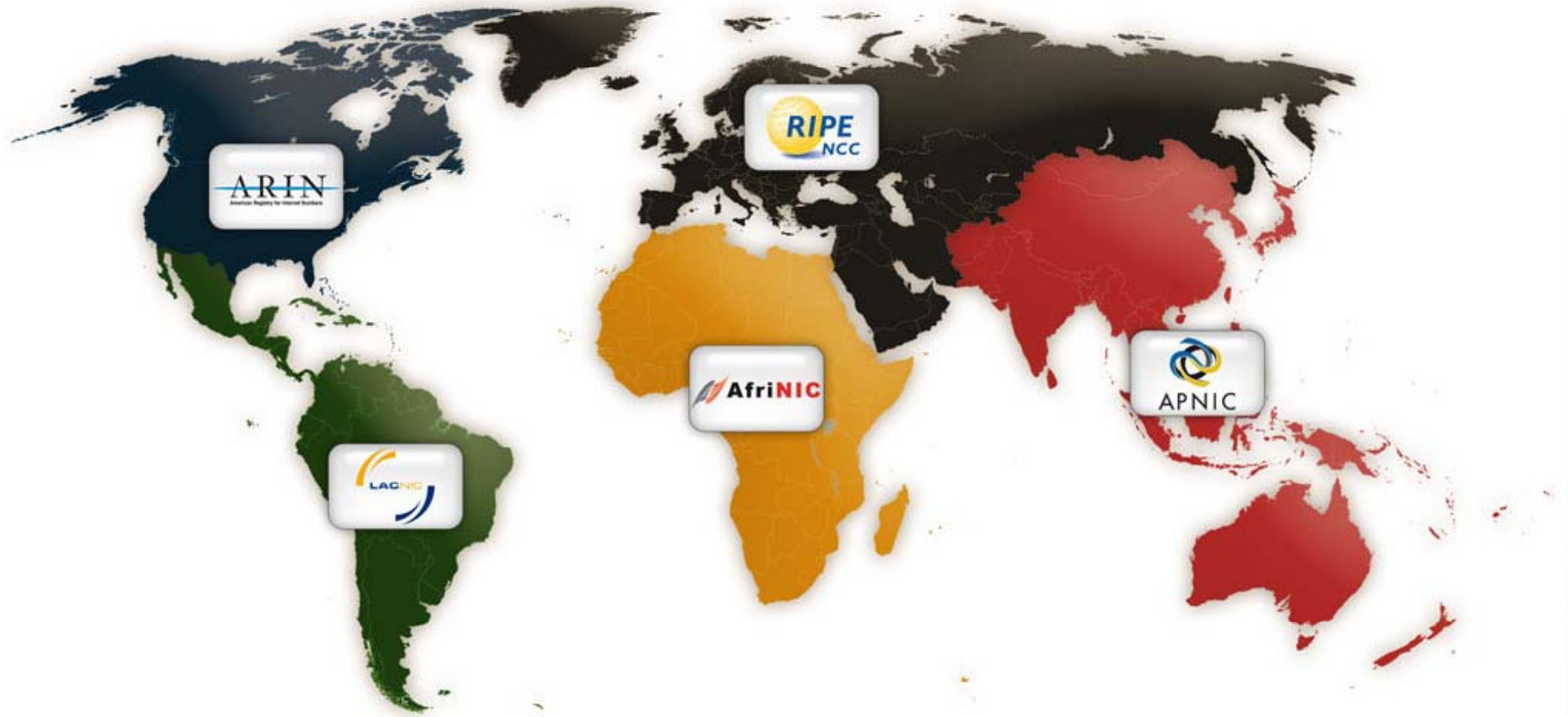
Distribution of Internet Number Resources

What's LACNIC?

- ◆ **Who manage the Numbering Internet Resources for the LAC assuring that all the interested parties have an equitable access to those resources and working based in spirit of stewardship and services to the community**
- ◆ **Not for profit, incorporated in Uruguay and recognized as an International Organization by the Uruguayan Government**
- ◆ **Membership based**
- ◆ **That works under policies that are developed in open, transparent and participative bottom up processes**
- ◆ **Who represents the effort of the regional industry to manage the above mentioned resources in a self-regulation manner**

- The **development of regional capabilities** through training and the transmission of Internet-related technology.



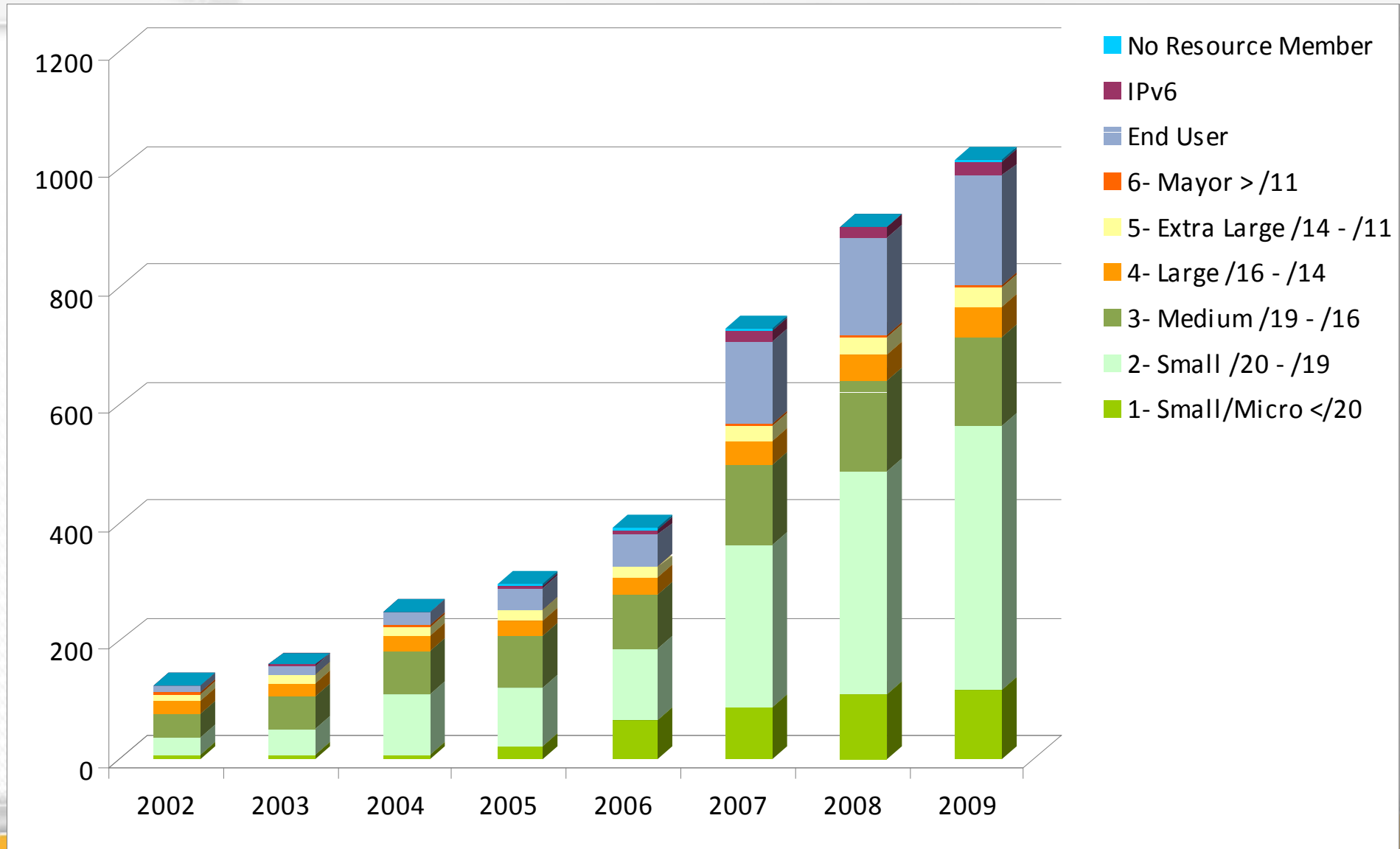

Membership Evolution



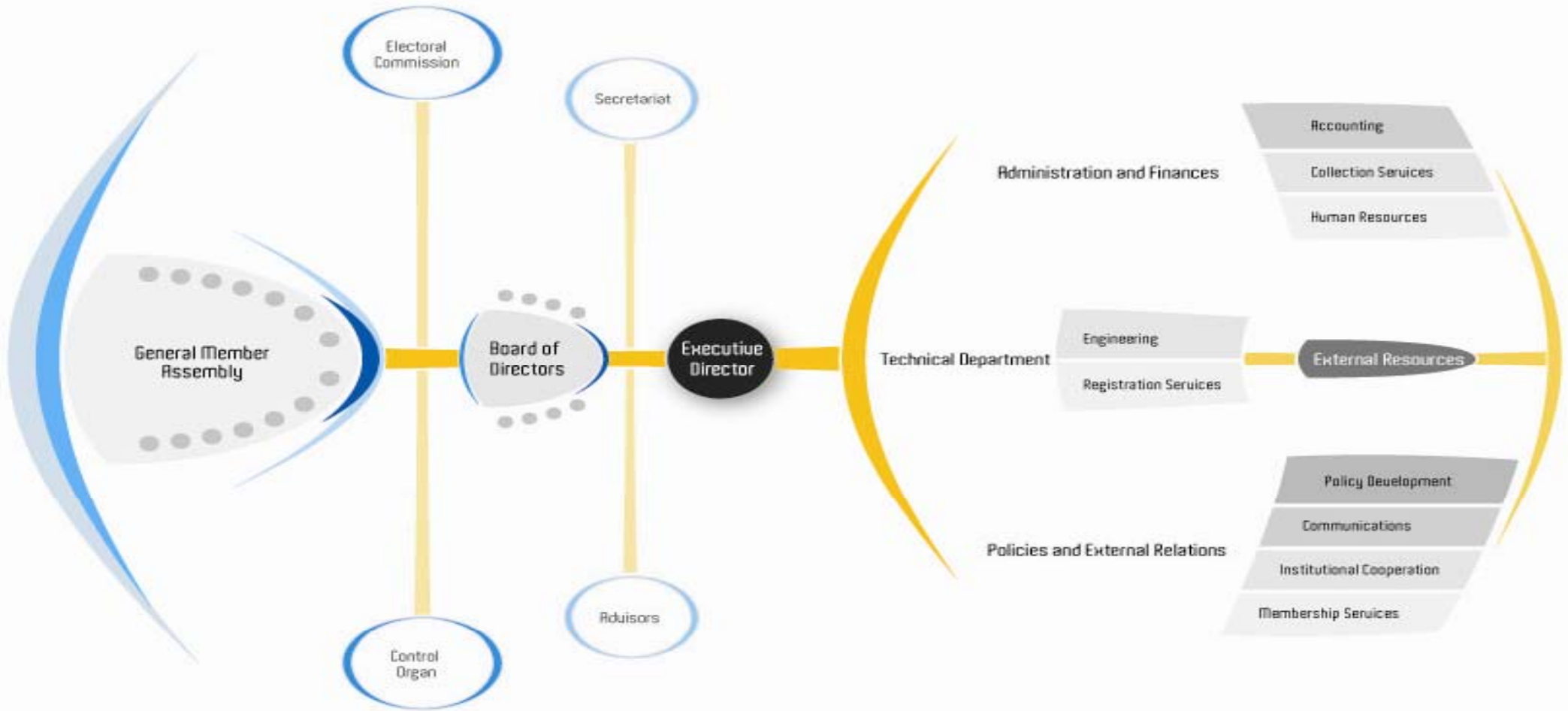


LACNIC member categories

- ◆ **Since last meeting, the board will have 7 members**

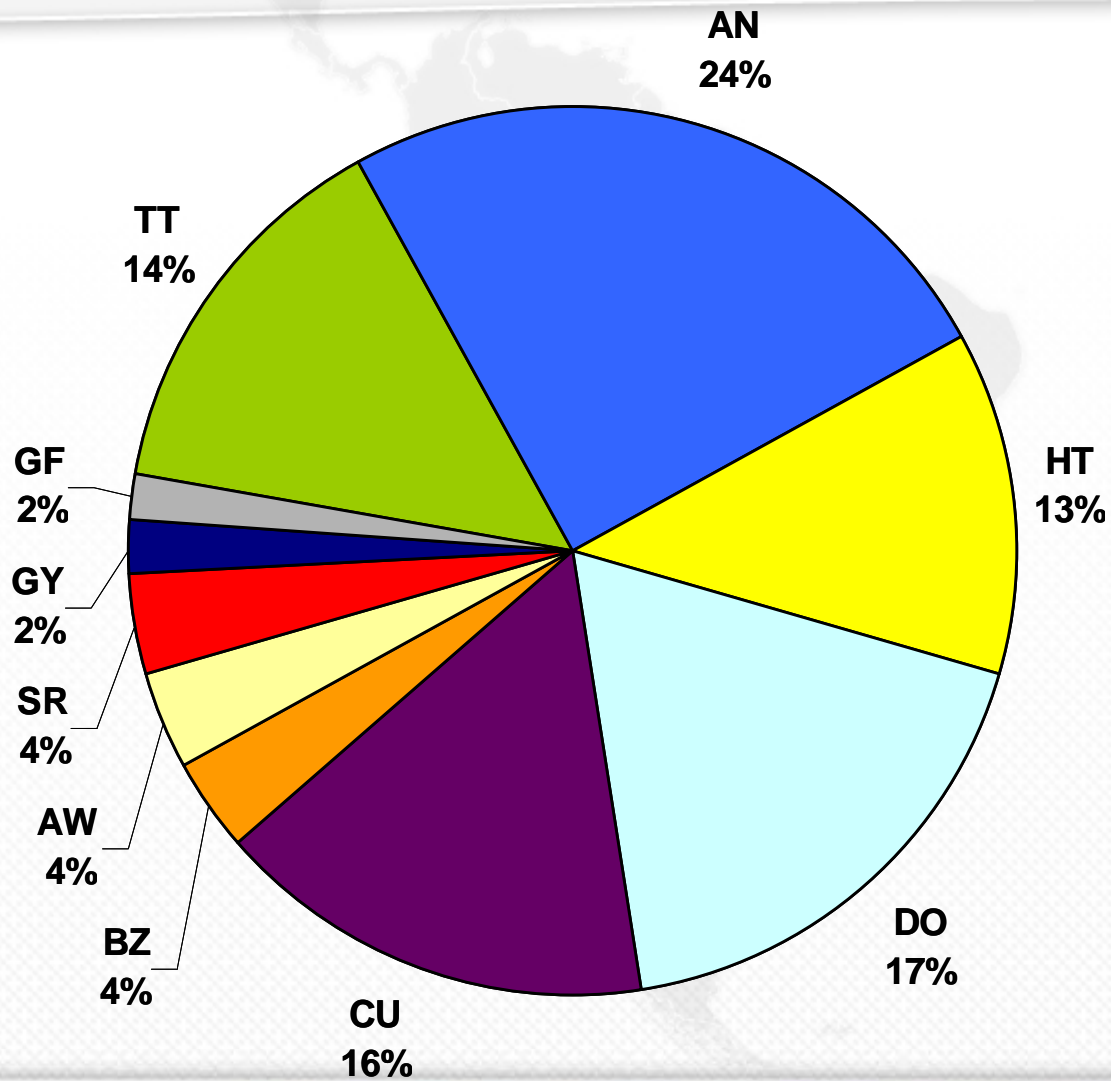


LACNIC and the Caribbean

- ◆ **LACNIC provides services in 10 countries/territories of the Caribbean (considering AN as 1).**
- ◆ **They represent about 75% of the Caribbean population but 30% of the internet users.**
- ◆ **They include English speakers countries, Dutch/Papiamento, Spanish and French speaking countries.**
- ◆ **5,5 % of the LACNIC members belong to the Caribbean region.**
