Registration Services

- Continued trend to very large IPv6 requests
 - Understanding found with IANA
- Co-evaluation of African requests
- Ongoing LIR Portal enhancements
- Group re-structured internally
 - Have IP Analysts, too...



Database / Software

- CRISP
 - Working towards early prototype
- Improved X.509 Database integration in LIR Portal
- IRRToolSet
 - Major development is complete
 - all outstanding bugs fixed
 - Migrating to ISC
- Support of admin processes
 - New LIR process
 - Contract re-signing

Operations

- Now includes operations of TTM, RIS, DNSMON networks
- k rootserver anycast
 - # 5 deployed in Doha (June)
 - # 6 deployed in Milano (August)
 - # 7 in Iceland (just now...)
 - In the pipeline:
 - Hungary, Switzerland, Finland, Russia, Poland, UAE
 - AP region with APNIC
- k rootserver now speaks IPv6
 - Currently only Amsterdam

Training Services

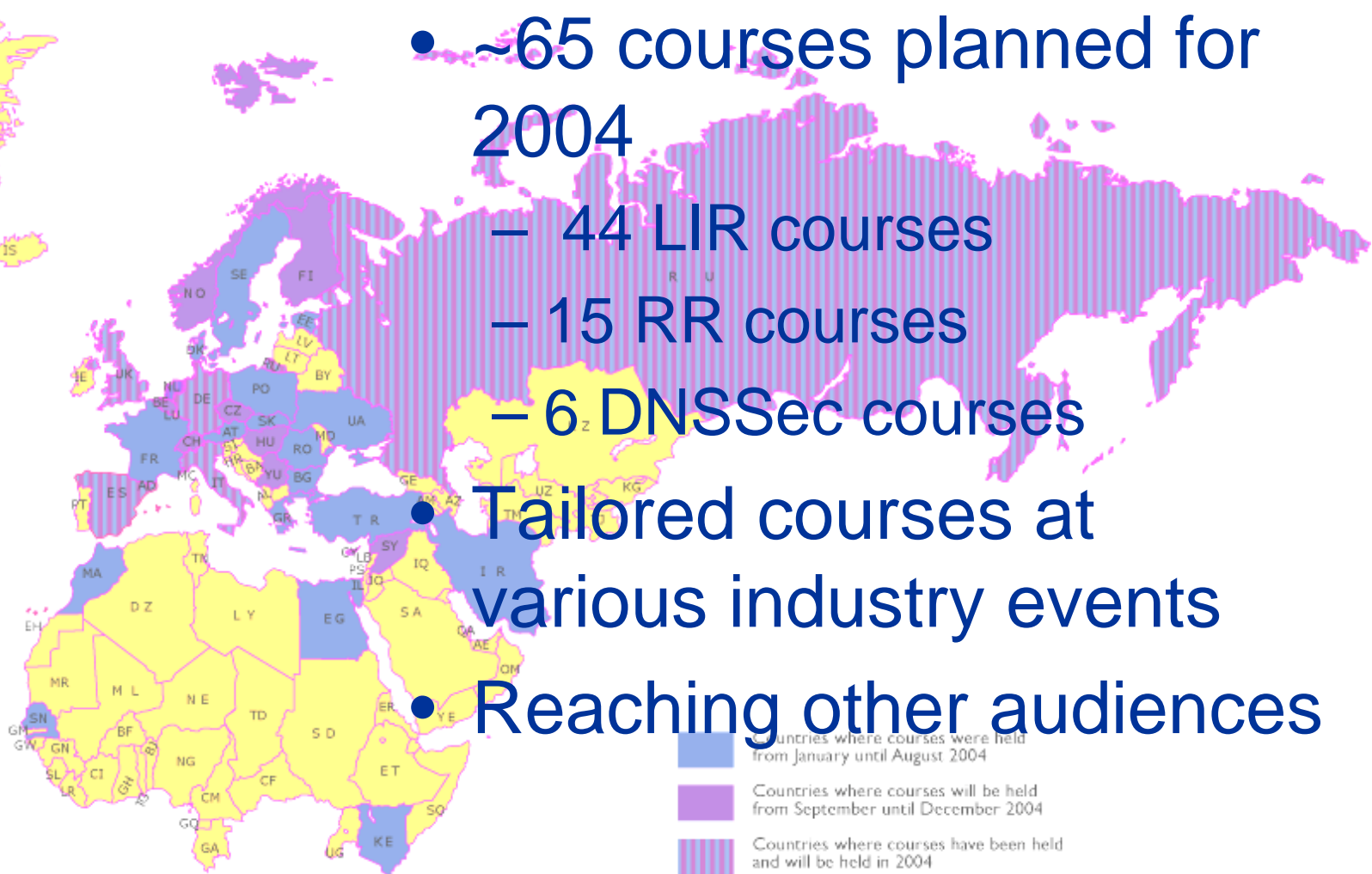
- ~65 courses planned for 2004

Corporate Governance

- General Meeting (II) on 24 September
- Members approved Charging Scheme 2005
 - XS, S, M, L, XL – 1.750, 2.250, 3.150, 4.750, 6.500 EUR resp.
 - Reduction against 2004 fees ca. 10%
- Supporting documents published.
 - Activity Planning Support Document
 - Draft Budget 2005
- Expected Membership Growth ~11 per cent.
 - Stronger growth this year than expected (> 3.700 currently)
 - Based on membership growth survey (through LIR portal)
- Re-Signing Standard Service Agreements
 - Due to Changes in Terms & Conditions approved earlier



RIPE Meeting Changes

- Number of meetings down to two
 - Test-run for 2005
 - Community concerns about continuity
- “Intersessional” meetings of WG chairs
 - Half-day meeting
 - Checkpoint for Action Points, Agenda preparations
 - To be used in Policy Development Process
 - First meeting set for January 2005
- Format of RIPE Meetings to be streamlined
 - EOF
 - RIPE NCC General Meeting / Services WG

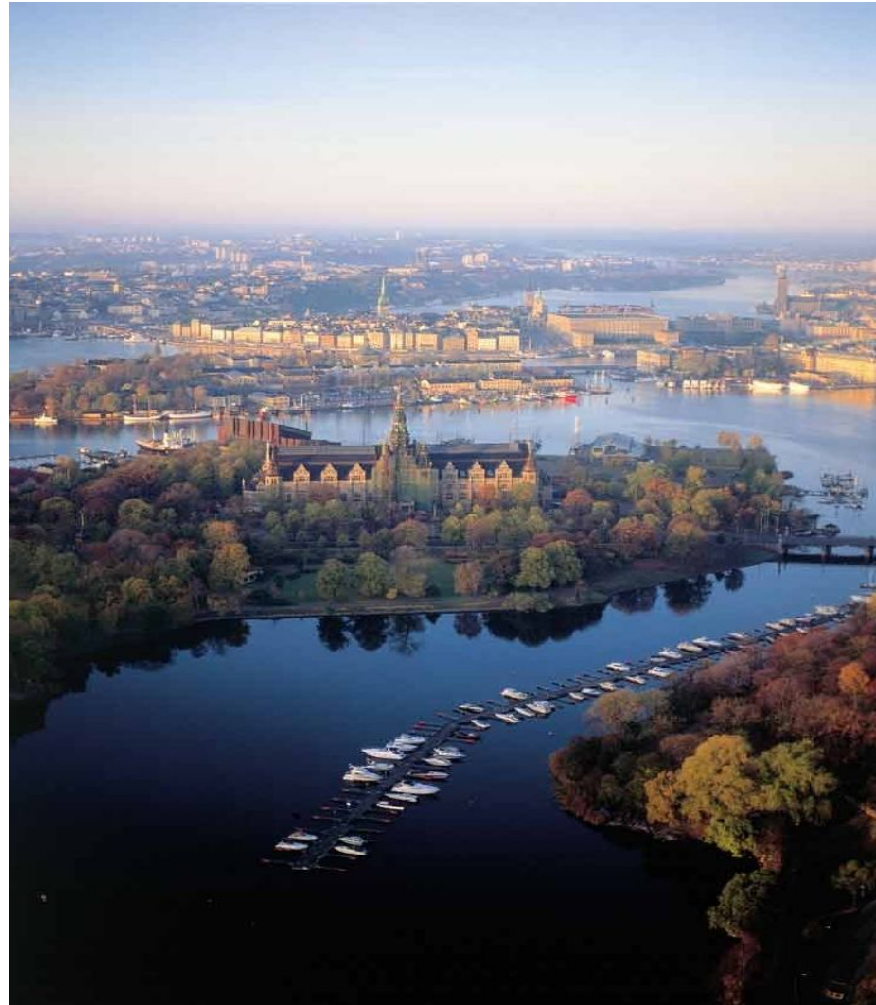


RIR Coordination
