

  - Discussing requirements with IAB

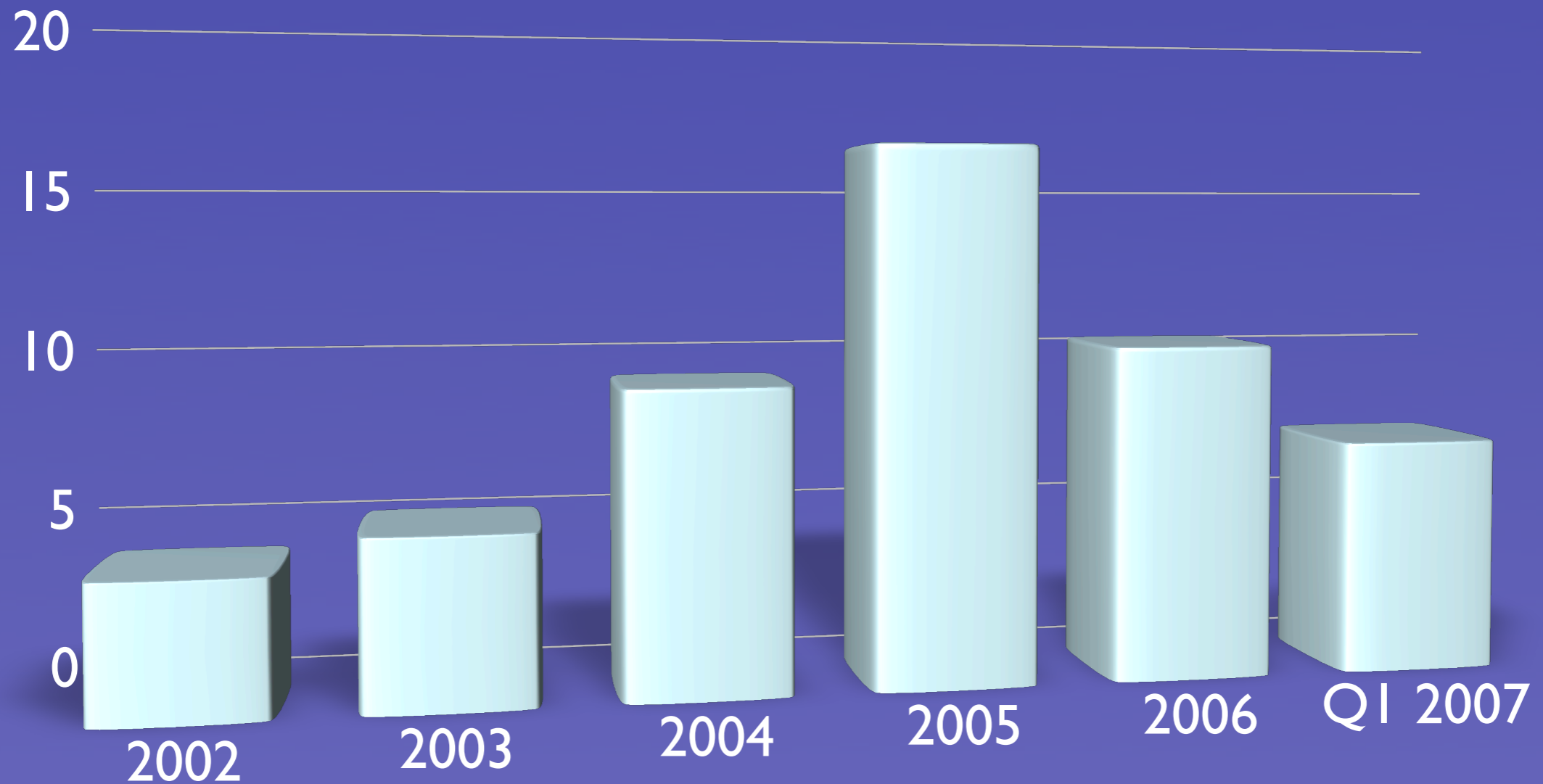

# Growing demand for IPv4

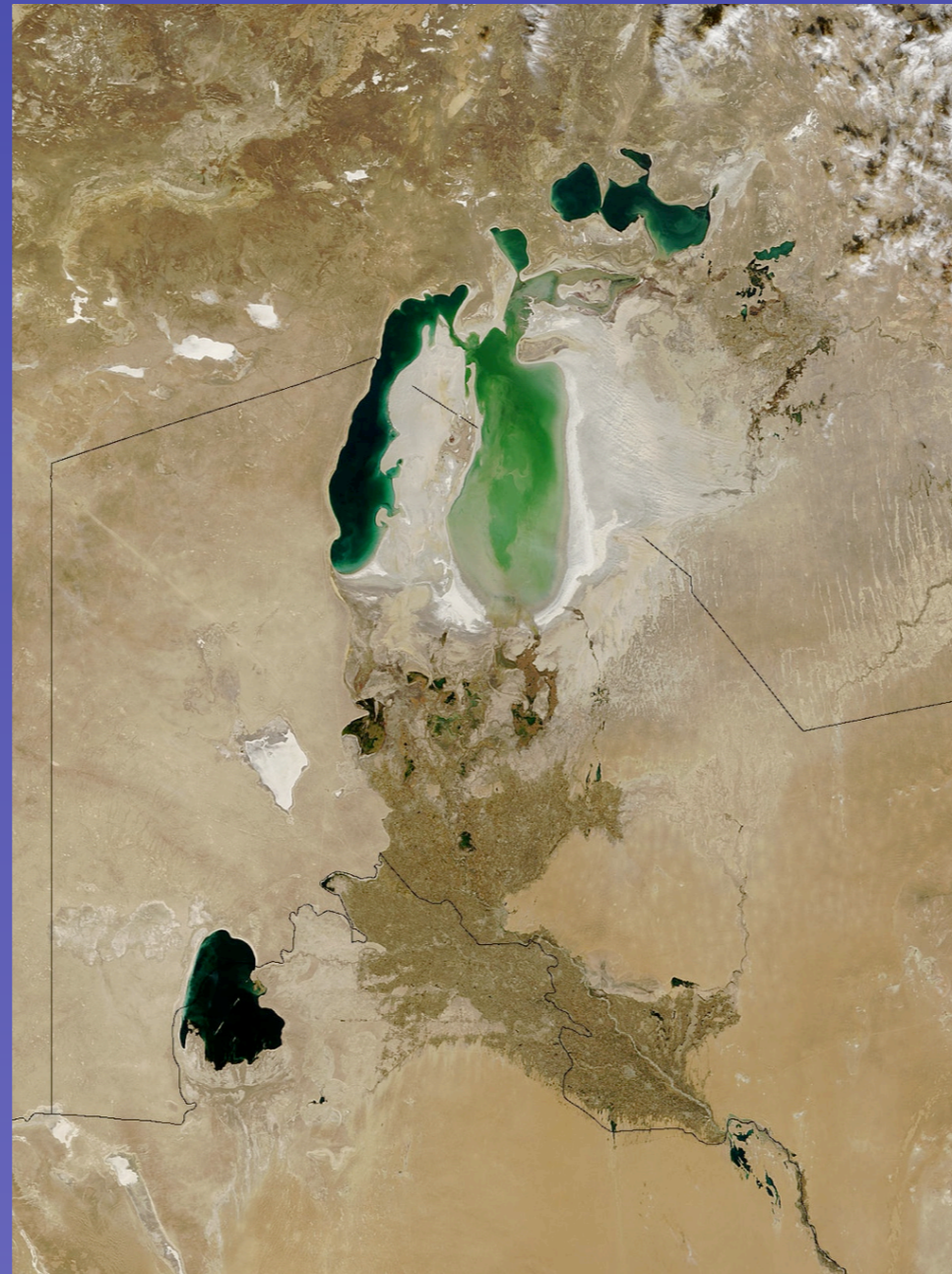

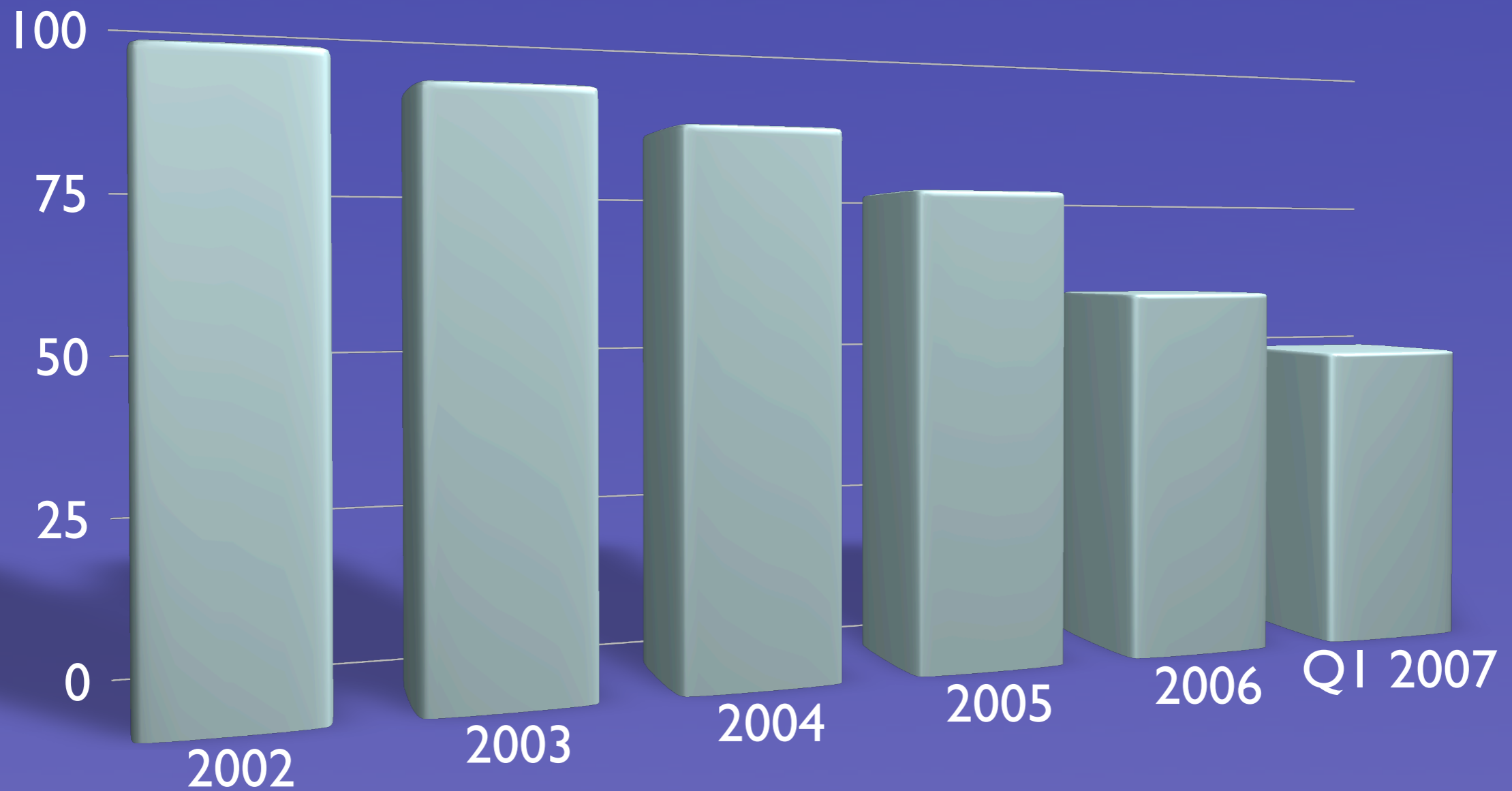
# The Aral Sea and IPv4
