LACSEC – Origins

- Where does LACSEC come from?
 - LACNIC recognized the relevance of computer and network security for the development of the Internet very early on
 - A mailing list is created in order to reach out to the security community within the region
 - First LACSEC held together with LACNIC IX in Guatemala City, May 2006

LACSEC – Organization

- Community centered around the mailing list and the annual conference
- Coordinated by a *moderator* elected by the community
- Current moderator:
 - Carlos Martinez Cagnazzo (UY)
 - Period ending 2011

- Bring together the security community within the LAC region
