Proposal Summary:

To update the “Multihoming” requirement with a more flexible one like “Interconnection Needs”. Those who have only one provider but can demonstrate needs of establishing peering with other networks can apply for this item.

Rationale:

There are cases where only one international provider exists or there are few alternatives available but the clients can connect themselves to a NAP or interconnect among themselves. In those cases, they will need their own IP addresses assigned by LACNIC.

Proposal Text:

2.3.3.4. Assignments to End Users

(...)

If the applicant is a multihomed end user or it has needs of interconnection:

The size of the minimum IPv4 address assignment to a multihomed end user is a /24. In order to qualify for a block the applicant must also satisfy the following requirements:

(...)

Those users that are planning to be multihomed or that are planning to establish interconnections with other autonomous systems in a period of six months can also apply. In these cases, they will have to justify with detail.
