2015 Focus

- Increased focus on customer service
 - Based on feedback and survey
- Continued IPv4 to IPv6 Transition Awareness
 - Targeting ISPs and Content Providers
- Continued participation in Internet Governance forums
 - To maintain the community-based multi-stakeholder policy development model
- Participate in planning discussions for the transition of the stewardship of IANA to encourage responsible oversight of critical Internet resources
- Continued development and integration of web-based functionality



Trends

- Customers continuing to make use of /24 minimum policy
 - Many first time requests, new to registry system
 - Upstreams sending their customers to ARIN
- Seeing an increase in market based transfers, including inter-RIR transfers
- More organizations opting to be added to the waiting list, currently 68 on the list
 - 13 requests satisfied by the /14 ARIN received on 1 SEP 2015 from the IANA



Operational Improvements

- Customer satisfaction survey
 - Working on follow up action items based on survey results
- Integrating transfers within ARIN Online
 - In-region done (NRPM Policy 8.3)
 - Working on inter-region transfers (NRPM Policy 8.4)



IPv4 Address Inventory Status

Free pool depleted on 24 Sep 2015 Options:


- Waiting List for Unmet Requests
- Transfers
 - Specified Transfer Listing Service
- Adoption of IPv6

Purpose Specific Inventory:

- One v4 /10 for NRPM 4.10 "Dedicated IPv4 block to facilitate IPv6 Deployment"
- 474 /24s for micro allocations to critical Internet infrastructure and exchange points.

IPv4 Transfers (thru 31 August 2015)

- Transfers to Specified Recipients (8.3)
 - 309 prefixes, ranging from /24 to /10
 - 20 ASNs
- Inter-RIR Transfers (8.4)
 - 175 prefixes, from /24 to /13
 - 174 ARIN to APNIC
 - 1 APNIC to ARIN
