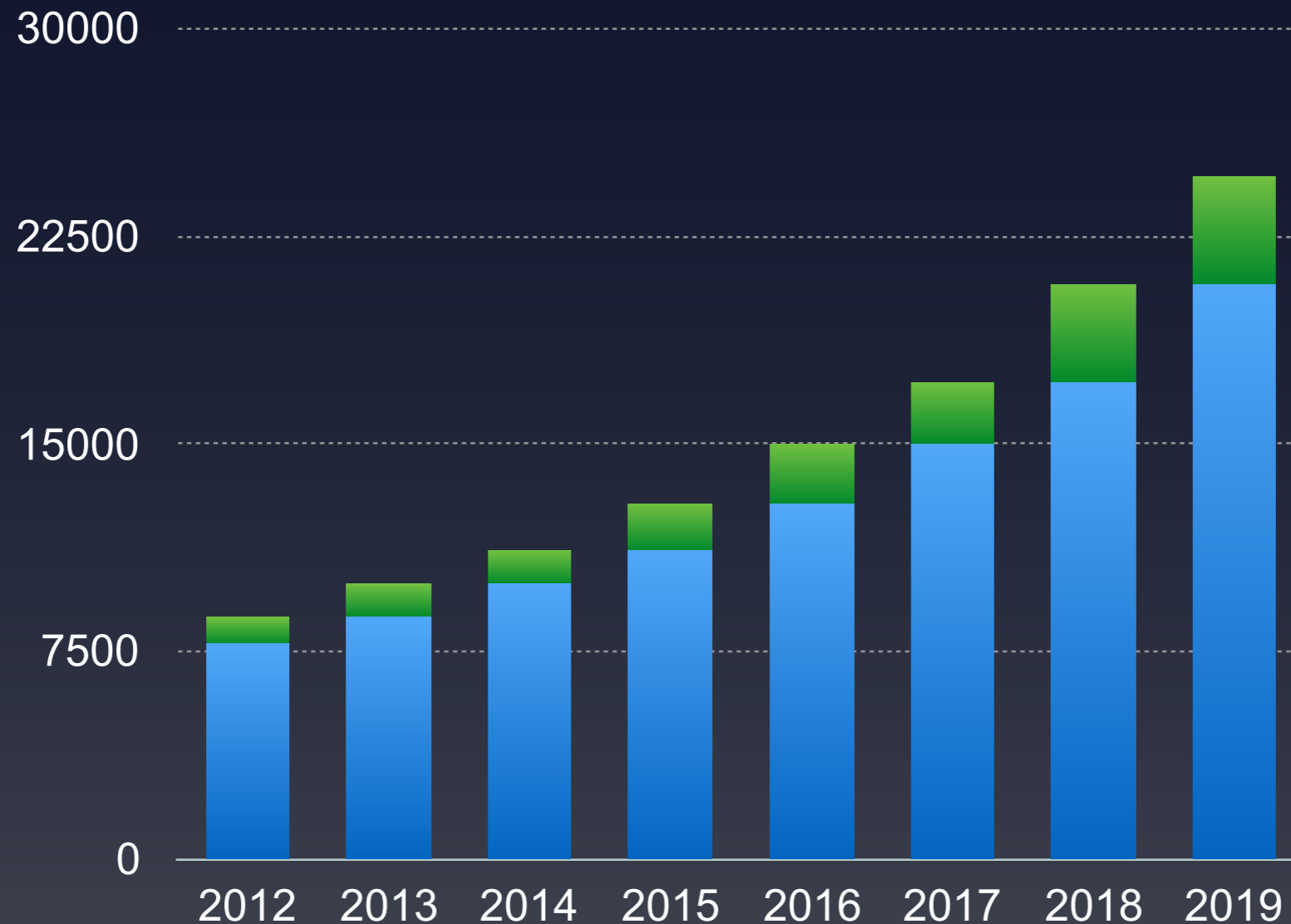

RIPE NCC Membership is Growing...



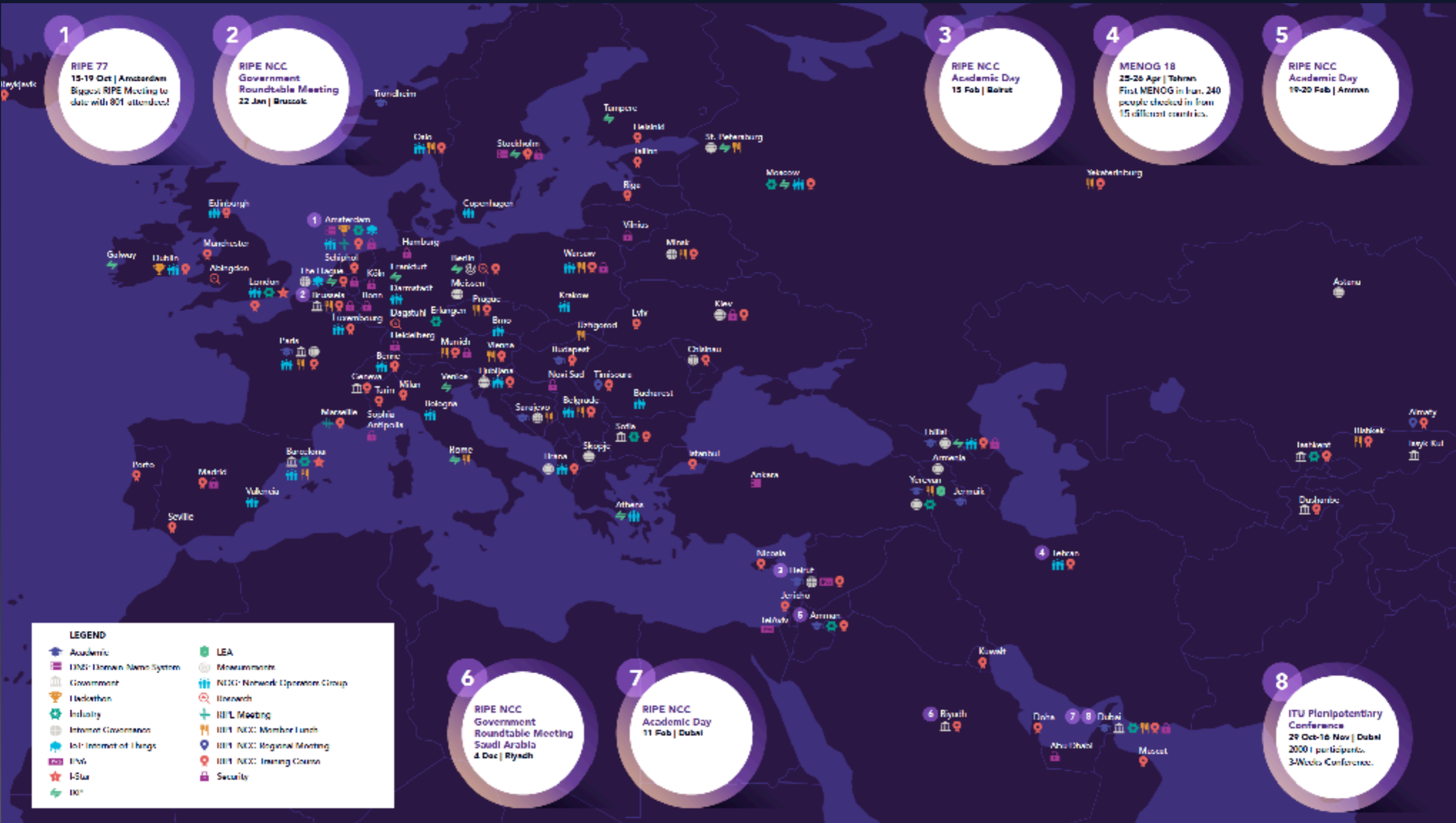
- Strong membership growth continues

Hackathons, Deployathons and more

- ‘Hackathons’ are usually two-day events
- Bringing together people interested in working on an issue e.g. Internet measurements, or ‘Quantum Internet’
- The ‘RPKI Deployathon’ brought together experts to help participants create ROAs and learn to configure routers

Network Operator Groups (NOGs)



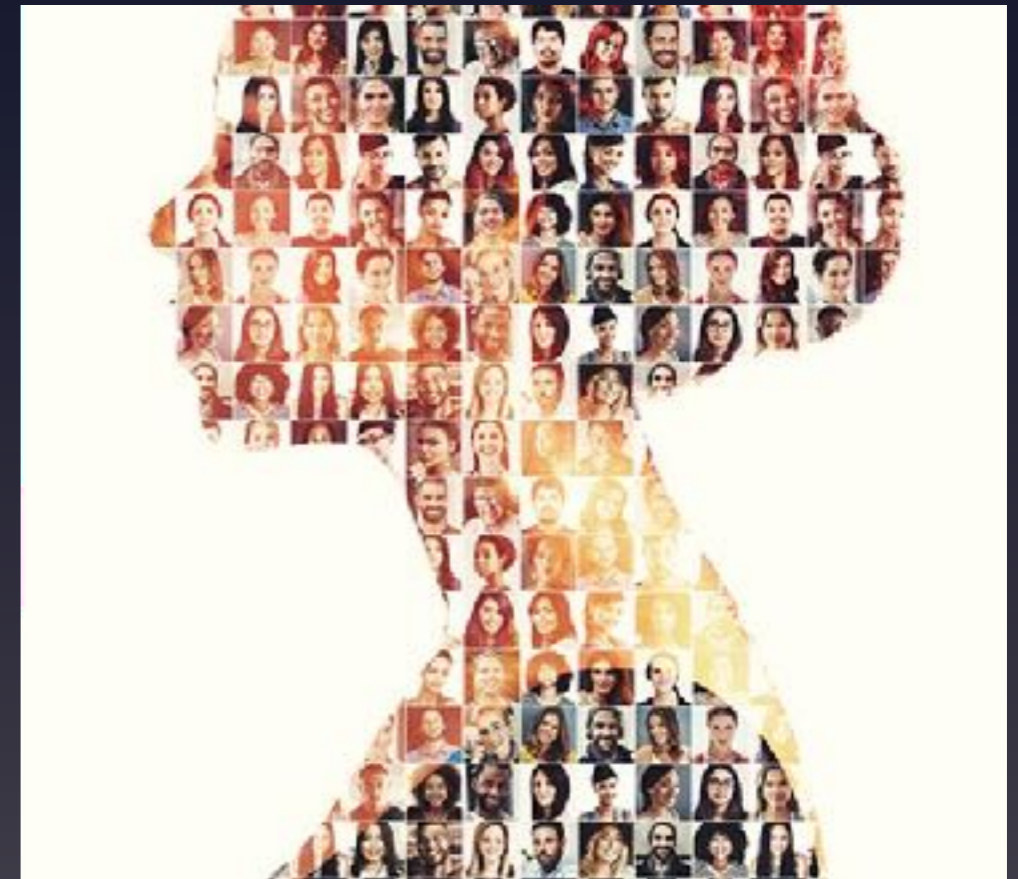
- NOGs help share expertise within local communities
