- 2019-01, “Clarification of Definition for “ASSIGNED PA””
- 2019-02, “IPv4 Waiting List Implementation”
- 2019-03, “BGP Hijacking is a RIPE Policy Violation”

IPv4 Waiting List Implementation



- Aims at creating a waiting list once the RIPE NCC's free IPv4 pool is exhausted
- Allocation will be reduced to a /24 (currently /22)
- Only for LIRs that have not received any IPv4 allocation from the RIPE NCC
- In Review Phase since 6 May

BGP Hijacking is a RIPE Policy Violation



- Aims to define that BGP hijacking is not accepted within the RIPE NCC service region
- RIPE NCC only receives the report, external experts evaluate whether a deliberate BGP Hijack took place
- Intense discussion on v1.0
- Currently RIPE NCC creates Impact Analysis on v2.0

Closed Proposals (since LACNIC30)



- 2018-04, “PDP Clarification” - Accepted
- 2018-05, “Publication of Legal Address of Internet Number Resource Holders” - Withdrawn
- 2018-02, “Assignment Clarification in IPv6 Policy” - Withdrawn
